Leon County Clerk & Comptroller Gwen Marshall is warning residents about a phone scam instructing victims to pay \$2,000 for missing jury duty.

The caller claims to be an employee of the Clerk & Comptroller tasked with making phone calls to people who are in contempt of court for missing jury duty. When citizens call the phone numbers they are given, they are greeted by a recording answering as the Leon County Sheriff's Office.

The elaborate scheme is one of many that are threatening residents with heavy fines or jail time.

Clerk Marshall advises citizens to be wary of unsolicited phone calls or suspicious emails. The Clerk & Comptroller's office does not make unsolicited phone calls regarding jury duty.

If you are targeted for a scam, do not provide any personal or financial information. You're encouraged to report it to your local law enforcement agency.
