ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2000-05 (AMENDMENT)

IN RE: Circuit and County Court Judges Assignments, Second Judicial Circuit

WHEREAS, there is a need to update a provision of Administrative Order 2000-05 every six (6) months pursuant to Wild v. Dozier, 672 So.2d 16 (Fla. 1996) to clarify the use of County Judges as Acting Circuit Judges when they are temporarily assigned to the Circuit Court bench; it is therefore

ORDERED that:

Section VIII (paragraph 2) of the above references Administrative Order is hereby amended as follows:

All county judges of the six (6) counties within the Second Judicial Circuit (Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, and Wakulla counties) are cross-assigned to serve as a circuit judge in any of the counties aforementioned. The county judges are temporarily assigned to the Circuit Court in their respective counties to supplement and aid the Circuit Court when the assigned circuit judge is not in the respective county or otherwise unavailable.
