ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2002-12

IN RE: COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS/LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Rule 2.050(b)(4) of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration provides that a Chief Judge shall assign judges to the court in divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

ORDERED that the following county court assignments shall become effective September 2, 2002, and expire at midnight June 30, 2003, unless earlier modified by subsequent order.

I. Criminal

County Judges Timothy Harley, James O. Shelfer and Don Modesitt shall be assigned to the Criminal Division together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings and trial dates and times associated therewith, as follows:

- A. County Judge Timothy Harley - Misdemeanor
- B. County Judge James Shelfer - Misdemeanor and First Appearances
- C. County Judge Don Modesitt - Traffic

II. Civil

County Judges Judith Hawkins and Augustus Aikens shall be assigned to the Civil Division together with all pending and previously scheduled trial dates and times associated therewith, as follows:

- A. County Judge Judith Hawkins: 50%
- B. County Judge Augustus Aikens: 50%

III. Miscellaneous Assignments

- A. County Judge Tim Harley is appointed and shall serve as the Administrative Judge for the County Court.
- B. The county judges shall continue to have jurisdiction over all simplified dissolution of marriage cases.
- C. This order shall not supersede other orders assigning county court judges on a temporary basis or any order establishing a county judge as a temporary backup to a circuit judge.
