## I. **LEON COUNTY**

Circuit Judge John E. Crusoe shall be assigned to the Criminal Division, Division E. Division E. shall be assigned all felony drug intervention cases and all worthless check cases together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings, trial dates and times associated therewith.

Circuit Judge John E. Crusoe shall be assigned to the juvenile division and assigned all juvenile delinquency cases together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings, trial dates and times associated therewith.

# C. Probate Division

Circuit Judge John E. Crusoe shall be assigned to the Probate Division and assigned all probate cases together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings, trial dates and times associated therewith.



### D. Collections Court

Circuit Judge John E. Crusoe shall assigned to all Leon County collection court cases.

## II. GADSDEN COUNTY AND LIBERTY COUNTY

Circuit Judge George S. Reynolds shall be assigned all circuit civil cases, family law cases, probate cases and juvenile dependency cases, including all civil appeals from county court, together with all pending and previously scheduled hearings, trial dates and times associated therewith.

This amended order shall become effective August 9, 2004. Administrative Order 2003-16 is still in effect unless modified by subsequent order.
