FIRST AMENDMENT

IN RE: **CIRCUIT AND COUNTY COURT JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS,  
SECOND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**


**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.050(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions, and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

**ORDERED** that Administrative Order No. 2005-02 is amended to read as follows:

1. Section I.A.1. is amended to provide that Circuit Judge James C. Hankinson shall retain the assignment of all currently pending cases in Division A of the Circuit Court Criminal Division in which the state is seeking the death penalty or there are collateral proceedings brought by a death row inmate, and shall retain such responsibility until such time as Circuit Judge John C. Cooper meets the requirements of Rule 2.050(b)(10), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.

2. Section I.C.1 is amended to provide that Circuit Judge Thomas Bateman III shall retain the assignment of all currently pending cases in Division C of the Circuit Court Criminal Division in which the state is seeking the death penalty or there are collateral proceedings brought by a death row inmate, and shall retain such responsibility until such time as Circuit Judge Jonathan E. Sjoström meets the requirements of Rule 2.050(b)(10), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.
